How can parishes use Neighbourhood Fund CIL monies?

The CIL regulations set out that the CIL Neighbourhood Fund has to be spent to support the development of the relevant area, funding:

- (a) The provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure;
- Or
- (b) Anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.

(CIL Regulations 59C and 59F)

This is clearly a very broad remit. Infrastructure has a very wide definition and includes transport, flood defences, schools, health facilities, parks and green spaces, cultural and sports facilities, as well as maintenance and improvement of facilities affected by development.
