

Dear Residents,

Kippax Parish Council, in partnership with Leeds City Council, is embarking on a project to improve Kippax Common Recreation Ground (off Green Avenue, Kippax, LS25 7DP) to make it an even better place to **play, connect and relax**.

Following the success of Kippax Skate Park and the approval of the <u>Kippax Neighbourhood Plan</u> which highlighted that "there are too few physical amenities, such as children's playgrounds and appropriate facilities that young people can appreciate" and that it should be prioritised for funding along with "improvements to existing open space areas" the Parish Council has allocated budget and resources to focus on Kippax Common over the coming years.

It's important to the Parish Council that the plans and direction for Kippax Common capture the needs and requirements of the whole community and so this survey is designed to capture your feedback on how you use Kippax Common now and what you might like to see in the future.

Following this initial survey, the Parish Council will be working to analyse your feedback to create plans and visualisations which will be presented back to the community for further consultation, feedback and amends.
